## ESSAY CONTEST

Years 5-12

To promote understanding and appreciation of Korean history and culture, KSCPP is hosting its **1<sup>st</sup> National Essay Contest in Australia**.

The Essay Contest is open to students in two groups: **Group A** (Years 5 - 8) and **Group B** (Years 9 - 12).

The entrants are required to read *Chung Hyo Ye, Tales of Filial Devotion, Loyalty Respect and Benevolence from the history and folklore of Korea*, published by KSCPP and available for free from [this link](#) (direct download) or [www.kscpp.net](http://www.kscpp.net) (project website).

### Essay Topic

Entrants should choose **one** of the following two questions:

1. How could the values of Chung, Hyo and Ye be applied in your daily life?
2. Which of the three values illustrated in the book (Chung, Hyo, Ye) impressed you and why?

### Awards (Gift card)

Prizes will be awarded separately for Group A (Years 5 - 8) and Group B (Years 9 - 12):

1<sup>st</sup> prize: \$500

2<sup>nd</sup> prize: \$200

3<sup>rd</sup> prize: \$100

Honorable Mentions: \$50\*

1. One-inch margin (top, bottom, left, and right); font size 12 (Times New Roman); double spaced; two to three pages in length.
2. Each essay must have the following information listed on the cover: i) Name ii) Age iii) Phone Number, Mailing Address & Email iv) School and Grade / Year.
