

## **'Haiku – Capturing a Moment' 2021 Entry Terms and Conditions**

By entering a piece in the 'Haiku – Capturing a Moment' writing Competition, you agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions.

1. Entries close **11.59 p.m., 30th September, 2021.**
2. The format of the Haiku must be adhered to.
3. It is open to all Australians.
4. Entry is online only.
5. Please ensure the submission of your Haiku does not include your name or any identifying marks. This is so when judging occurs there is no advantage. When submitting via email please attach Haiku via .pdf or .doc to the email.
6. Entries must be the original work of the applicant and must not have been previously published in any form.
7. All authors must include all details of Name, Address and Telephone Number on the entry email for administrative purposes. There is a limit of **ONE entry per person and TWO Haiku per entry.**
8. Members of the 'ArtSpace Pop Up Gallery' and the 'Independent Writers Group' together with their family members are not eligible for prize money but may submit Haiku for any future publications resulting from the 'Haiku – Capturing a Moment' competition.
9. Entrants must be over the age of 18.
10. The judges' decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into with the judges.
11. By entering the 'Haiku – Capturing a Moment' competition, the author gives permission to publish their work in booklet form to be used as documentation of the event and distribution to participants of the 'Haiku – Capturing a Moment' competition. By entering the author also gives permission to the event facilitator for the use of their Haiku in any 'Art installation' created. The author of the Haiku's name will accompany the Haiku used on the artwork. The copyright to the work is always retained by the author. As publisher of the booklet the facilitators of 'Independent Writers Group' and the 'ArtSpace Pop Up Gallery' have First Publication Rights to all submitted works and may use any title or phrase from any entry for the purpose of promoting the competition and the booklet and any subsequent future events and competitions. Any collection or publication after the 'Haiku – Capturing a Moment' Competition that includes the authors' Haiku should acknowledge the 'Haiku – Capturing a Moment', 'Independent Writers Group' and the 'ArtSpace Pop Up gallery' of the Central Coast.
12. The author of the Haiku gives permission for the Haiku submitted to be used in performance/art on the day of the 'Art Space Pop Up Gallery Event' celebrating the competition.
13. By supplying your contact details, you agree to us sending you opt-out correspondence.
14. Once submissions close, Haiku may be posted as promotion of the event in the lead up to the announcement of the winners.
15. Announcement of the winners will be made on 9th October, 2021 at 2 p.m. at the ArtSpace Pop Up Gallery, 211B The Entrance Road, The Entrance, NSW. More details to be provided.
16. Winners will be notified via telephone at which time bank details for payment of the prize will be asked to be provided for transfer of prize money within 7 business days.
